



### **Portfolio of Creative Work**

A portfolio is required as a central part of the application to the professional Architecture degree program. Content is not restricted to any particular subject area, but the material should be in the form of a cohesive presentation and should be representative of your previous experience and creative abilities. It may include both graphic and written material. We recommend that the portfolio not exceed an 11-by-17-inch format, and that any loose pages be marked plainly with your name. The work represented in the portfolio—whether it includes drawings, photographs of architectural models, or artwork (including various types of media such as paintings, sculpture, ceramics, or photography)—should be the best examples of the applicant’s efforts.

Portfolios can also be submitted digitally as one PDF file at a maximum of 30 MB.

**Important:** Applicants submitting work done collaboratively, either in school or in the profession, should be as specific as possible about the extent of their personal involvement in such projects.
