This camp is all-inclusive. Participants will stay on campus in East Laville and dine on campus (3 meals a day, one meal Sunday and two meals Friday). Campers will exhibit their work on Friday, June 17 in Atkinson Hall, home of LSU School of Architecture. Parents and families are welcome to attend this end of camp event. The closest paid meter parking is available at LSU Bookstore. Campers will pack up their dorm rooms and store belongings earlier in the day for easy drive up pick up at East Laville.

Note: For security and parking reasons, students are not permitted to bring a car. Participants are given minimal access to the computer labs on campus; it is not necessary to bring a laptop or tablet. During studio time, campers will be engaging in a series of activities and design challenges. They will be exploring their ideas through the creation of drawings and models. This work will require their full attention and BOTH HANDS! Cell phone use will not be permitted during studio time.

Packing Checklist
